It will be a place of interesting debate, creative workshops and visionary ideas. The Futurium will be open to everyone who is looking forward to the future and to shaping it. It will give its visitors a glimpse of the future by letting them explore, debate and try out many things for themselves. It will present future scenarios and their challenges, chances and risks as well as the building blocks that we will likely use to shape the future. At the same time, the Futurium will be a place that facilitates discourse between the worlds of politics, science, business and society about what our future will look like. All of this will be accommodated by over 3.000 square meters of space provided by the building that houses the museum of the future.
